Phase III Step II Protocols

- No hockey bags allowed. Locker rooms and showers are closed. All skaters must arrive fully dressed. You may only bring in your skates, gloves, helmet and stick.
- Masks must be worn in the facility at all times. This includes on the ice. Everyone in the Graf must remain 6' apart. The mask and social distancing policy are to extend to the entrances, exits and parking lots.
- Spectators are limited to 2 parents and siblings. Siblings must remain with parents and are not to be left unattended at any point in time. The Graf will switch to a no-spectator policy should this rule not be followed.
- You may arrive for your ice time 15 minutes ahead of your skate and no earlier. The Graf must be closed by 9:30pm each day.
- Coaches must leave rosters at the check-in table. Please include the date, time you are skating and phone numbers for all participants. Everyone entering the rink must take their temperature and scan the QR code. All parents must sign in at the table in the vestibule.
- The front doors are only used to enter. The side door (located on the Zamboni side of the rink) must be used to exit.

All rules are subject to change.

Those found to be non-compliant will lose all ice privileges at the Graf.
